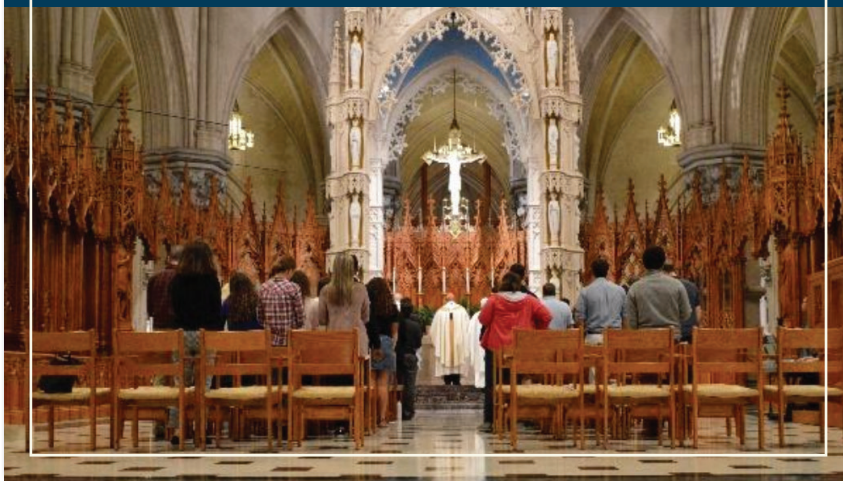

Evangelizing Our College Students

The Office of Campus Ministry of the Archdiocese of Newark has been providing pastoral services for our public colleges and universities for well over 50 years. Also known as the "Newman Apostolate" we serve ten non-Catholic campuses throughout four counties: Essex County College, Fairleigh Dickinson University (Teaneck), Kean University, Montclair State University, New Jersey City University, New Jersey Institute of Technology, Ramapo College, Rutgers University (Newark), Stevens Institute of Technology, and Union County College.

Our mission is to bring the Gospel message of Jesus Christ to the college students and campus communities we serve in a variety of ways that assist in furthering their spiritual, moral, and intellectual development. Our full-time lay campus ministers, alongside our chaplains, work in collaboration with the different Student Life offices on each campus to continue fostering these unique partnerships of service. This access allows us to offer Mass and Confession on a regular basis, conduct bible studies and RCIA for students, and other ministries you would find in your local parish; it also allows us to sponsor larger "outreach" events to engage the broader, diverse campus communities.

Over the years, the students of the Newman Apostolate have organized various community events, such as campus-wide drives to collect blood and bone marrow donations. Through Newman-sponsored service opportunities, student communities such as athletic teams and Greek organizations have been able to serve the poorest of the poor and be exposed to the Church in an unconventional way. It is not uncommon to find widespread support and co-sponsorships from our campus communities when our students are bringing sandwiches to Newark Penn Station, partnering with Midnight Run to bring clothing, food, and toiletries to several locations for the homeless in Manhattan, coordinating food and clothing drives for local pantries, or working at a local garden in Paterson that provides fresh fruits and vegetables for those in need.

Most people are surprised to learn that although the campuses we serve are generous and hospitable with time and space, our mission is almost entirely operated and funded through the generous support of the Sharing God's Blessings Annual Appeal. We are immensely grateful for all that you do to help this generation grow in their love and relationship with the Lord Jesus and His Church.

As a side note, the Newman Apostolate was named for the newly canonized Saint John Henry Newman. His canonization took place on October 13, 2019.
